Dear Valued Member:

County Federal will be awarding educational scholarships to graduating high school seniors and post-secondary students* enrolled in an accredited university or community/technical college on a full and part-time basis.** Awards will range from \$500 to \$1,500. Scholarships will be payable in one installment directly to your educational institution in August prior to the Fall 2020 semester.

All participating students will be required to complete the attached application, one Online Financial Education Playlist, write an essay and attach a copy of their most current high school or college transcript to the application.

Scholarships will be judged on completing one Online Financial Education Playlist (5%), Cumulative GPA (10%), Community and High School involvement (15%) and an essay (70%).

The recipients will be notified by **June 16th, 2020**. Recipients may be featured in Country Federal's media, marketing and other promotional material.

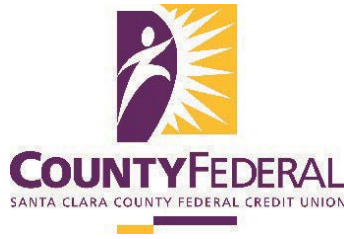

2020 Educational Scholarship Application

County Federal will be awarding scholarships to graduating high school seniors and post-secondary students enrolled in an accredited university or community/technical college on a full and part-time basis. Awards will range from \$500 to \$1,500. Scholarships will be payable in one installment in August prior to the Fall 2020 semester.

All eligible applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Student must be a **member** in good standing with Santa Clara County Federal Credit Union
2. Student must be a graduating high school senior or post-secondary student - ages 17 to 25
3. Student must have a Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
4. Student must carry a minimum of 6.0 units (part-time college)
5. Student must be in good standing with their high school/college and may not be on disciplinary or academic probation
6. Letter of Acceptance and Verification of Enrollment need to be provided by **August 31st, 2020**

Scholarship Scoring Criteria:

- 5% Online Financial Education Playlist
- 10% Cumulative Grade Point Average
- 15% Community and High School/College Involvement
- 70% Written Essay

- Community Activities and Volunteer Experience - Give a brief description/objective and date for each activity.

4. Written Essay - 70%

- Please answer this essay question:
 - **Credit Unions are financial cooperatives that operate from the philosophy of "people helping people." Service to our members and community is an integral part of the County Federal's Credit Union difference. Tell us about a goal that you have set for yourself to give back to your community and what impact you think it has had or will make in the future.**
- Essay must be typed, double-spaced and not exceed two pages in length.
- Essay will be judged on clarity of expression, content, composition and originality.
